## INTRODUCTION





#### **Mbox Director Software Version 5.4.1**

We are pleased to announce that software version 5.4.1 is now available for the Mbox Director application. Director version 5.4.1 addresses several critical issues in the Mbox Director application.

# Compatibility with Apple Silicon Processors - M1/M2/M3/M4 - and macOS versions

Mbox Director is a universal application and runs <u>natively</u> on both Apple Silicon and Intel computers. Director requires at least macOS 10.14.6 and is compatible with all versions of macOS up to and including macOS 15 Sequoia. The use of macOS 16 Sequoia is <u>still discouraged</u> at this time due to bugs in the OS. If you must use Sequoia and have issues using Mbox Director, please contact <u>MboxSupport@prg.com</u> for assistance.

**IMPORTANT!!** Future versions of Mbox Director will <u>eliminate</u> support for older versions of macOS. Director 5.4.x will be the <u>last</u> version with support for macOS Mojave (10.14) and possibly Catalina (10.15).

#### **Corrected Issues**

- + Fix profile issue that caused a newly-patched (using Director 5.4) instance of Mbox Studio not to work correctly and which affected all layers of that server.
- + Fix issue in Tahoe where the use of up/down arrow keys when editing values in the Scene List could cause values to disappear.
- + Fix occluded text/image that appears when an Mbox server is in Monitor Only mode.
- + Fix alert shown when MTC is the selected timecode source but MIDI is not enabled.
- + Improve tooltip warning language when Director can't receive replies from Mbox.

### **Updated Features**

- + The concept of DHCP "quarantine" has been eliminated and Director will no longer flag instances of Mbox on DHCP networks as needing special permission to connect.
- + Revised application icon compatible with macOS 26 Tahoe's new icon shape.
